INDONESIA: PRAMOEDYA Ananta Toer  
JUSUF Ishak  
JUSUF Verdi  
and three students

Jusuf Verdi and the other three students were released from detention on 10 October 1981.

Pramoedya Ananta Toer was not detained after the evening of 5 October, as originally reported. Instead, he was required to report daily to the military; this is no longer the case, however.

Jusuf Ishak is still in detention. Since his arrest on 5 October, he has not been visited by any family member or lawyer. He is held in the military detention centre on Jalan Guntur (street name) in Jakarta. AI is further concerned about Jusuf Ishak as he has a heart condition which is not receiving medical attention.

Further recommended action:

- Please stop all action on behalf of Jusuf Verdi and the three students.
- Please continue to send appeals on behalf of Jusuf Ishak, expressing concern at his state of health and his continued detention for having peacefully exercised his right to freedom of expression. Urge his immediate and unconditional release.
